











































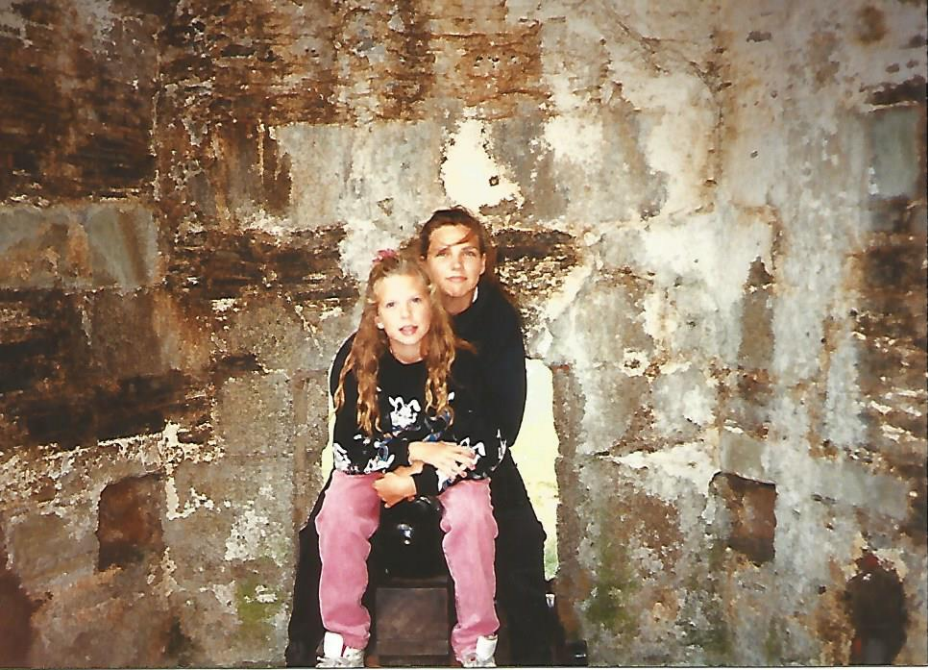

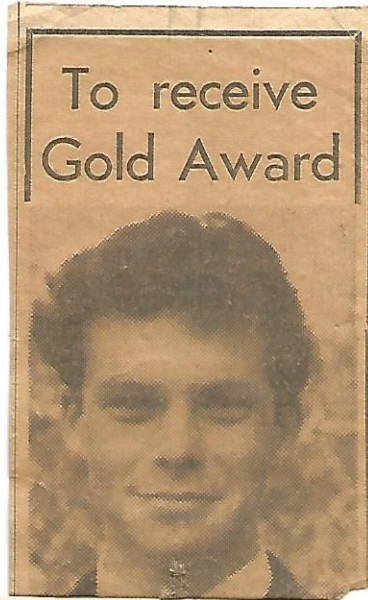

## ADMITTANCE

Guests will enter through the Main Gate and Grand Entrance of Buckingham Palace. Only those in possession of a white admittance card will be admitted. The Gates will open from 2 p.m. and you are requested to arrive not later than 2.30. p.m. Those coming by car should allow sufficient time for parking.

## ADMITTANCE BY PARENTS OR GUESTS:

Because of the limited space available in the Ballroom of Buckingham Palace, and so that the largest number of Award Winners may attend this Reception, it is regretted that the invitation to witness the ceremony can only be extended to one parent or guest for each Winner.

## PROCEDURE

On arrival in the Palace, Parents and Guests will be directed to seats in the Ballroom.

## PHOTOGRAPHS

As stated on the admittance card, you should not bring a camera **into** the Palace. Some Press photographers will be present in the Quadrangle after the ceremony.
